**Spelling Contract**

In order to practice the list of your 20 required words for the week, read the choices below to decide what activities you would like to complete for your contract. You may choose any combination of activities as long as they add up to 100 points or more. Spelling Contracts are due **FRIDAY** morning and no later! However, you may turn them in WITH THE CONTRACT cover sheet at any time! **Circle the activities** that you accomplish each week and staple them behind this front page. Write the total number of points in its designated area at the bottom of this sheet. Your 5 bonus words and 6 Core Writing words are not included in these activities (see below).

**\*\*6 Core Writing Words assignment:** Write a fourth grade sentence (makes sense, all sentences don't begin with the word "I", and has correct punctuation) for all words. Please underline the word in the sentence.

**25 Point Activities** – each activity is worth 25 points

1. Write ALL 20 of your words 3 times each with at least three different colors
2. Write each of your 20 words and divide the word into syllables by drawing a line
3. Write the word and definition of the word (from a dictionary) for at least 10 of your words
4. I Spy: Draw a picture and hide ALL 20 of your words inside the picture
5. Write ALL 20 of your words as many times as there are syllables in that word (example: lightning has 2 syllables so you would write it 2 times)
6. Write ALL 20 of your words in ABC order
7. Write ALL 20 of your words in order from longest word to shortest word AND then from shortest word to longest word
8. Write each of your 20 words and draw a colorful, creative border around the letters

**50 Point Activities** – each activity is worth 50 points

10. Write ALL 20 of your words in cursive handwriting two times each
11. Draw a creative and colorful picture for all 20 of your words and write the spelling word underneath your picture
12. Write a fourth grade sentence for each word and underline the spelling word in each sentence (check punctuation)
13. Make a crossword puzzle on a sheet of graph paper using at least 10 of your words (write the questions at the bottom and include the answers)
14. Cut out letters (not words) from old magazines or newspapers to use to spell at least 10 of your words and paste them on a sheet of construction paper (can get magazines and paper at school – see Mrs. Willhite)☺
15. Make a picture dictionary using ALL of your words: make a small book out of notebook paper, write your words on each page or 2 words per page, and draw a picture for each word
16. Choose 10 spelling words and make as many words out of each. Don't combine all the letters from the 10 words, only use one word to create new words
17. Look up each of your words in the dictionary and write the two guide words from the page that it was found on in the dictionary

**75 Point Activities** – each activity is worth 75 points

18. Write a creative story using all of your words. It must be at least 20 sentences long, it must make sense, and your words must be underlined
19. Write a poem using 10 of your words in your best cursive handwriting, give it a title, and illustrate it
20. Write a TV commercial for anything that you would like to sell using at least 10 words from your list
21. Make a game that uses all of your words (include game pieces and instructions)
22. Create a product on a poster that you would like to sell and use 10 of your words to advertise it on the poster. Your poster must include the product name, illustration, and cost
23. Pretend you are a news anchor, weather person, or reporter. Use at least 10 of your spelling words to write a report
24. Create a comic strip and write captions using all of your words. Underline your words and illustrate each caption.
25. Make a collage representing the meanings of all of your words.
